

The 2026 St. Louis and ANCHOR Hip Skills Course aims to advance surgeon expertise in contemporary surgical techniques and clinical decision-making in hip preservation surgery. Through focused, hands-on training and case-based discussions, the course fosters excellence in the care of patients with young adult hip disorders.

This two-day hands-on cadaver course will focus on indications and advanced surgical techniques for hip preservation surgeries, including periacetabular osteotomy (PAO), PFO, surgery hip dislocation and hip arthroscopy. Led by leading ANCHOR surgeons in the field, the course includes didactic, round table discussions, and hands-on cadaver labs.
